WELCOME TO EICHARDT'S PRIVATE HOTEL

Perched on the edge of Lake Wakatipu, Eichardt's Private Hotel has a long tradition of warm hospitality and crafting beverages, holding Queenstown's oldest continuous license to sell alcohol.

Tahuna, as Queenstown was initially known, was first visited by The Ngai Tahu iwi over 700 years ago during Summer months to hunt Moa and find pounamu.

When European settlers ventured to New Zealand, William Gilbert Rees was among the first. He built a woolshed in 1859 to support his farming endeavours but a short two years later, offered it as accommodation to miners when gold was found in the Shotover River. The woolshed was soon demolished and The Queen's Arms Hotel erected in its place.

Over the years, the hotel grew into a first-class establishment in the town. In 1866, Rees entered into partnership with Albert Eichardt, who became the proprietor of the hotel during the same year. By 1868, Albert Eichardt married Julia Shanahan, the former proprietress of the hotel and dining room manager. In the following year, Eichardt would become the sole proprietor of the hotel, renamed Eichardt's Queen's Arms Hotel and later known simply as Eichardt's Private Hotel.

As the gold glint faded and Queenstown shifted from a mining settlement to a town with more permanence, the hotel began to cater to a new kind of patronage—tourists.

For more than 160 years, the Eichardt's reputation for hospitality and generosity has never wavered, and an icon has endured. Nevertheless, its story is still being written.

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PRE-COCKTAIL & BIRTH OF COCKTAILS ROME-1800S

Flavours of the Frontier

Before the word cocktail even entered the English lexicon, global explorers, traders, and early settlers shared drinks that blended spirit, spice, and story. This era birthed punches, and early forms of the “cock-tail” — a term first recorded in 1806, describing a spirited mix of alcohol, sugar, water, and bitters.

These are the drinks one might have found in the infancy of Eichardt's.
In Goldfield tents, Victorian parlours, or beside roaring fires on cold alpine nights.

Eichardt's traces its roots to this era: founded in 1861 amid the Otago gold rush and Queenstown's founding years. A bustling haven for miners and pioneers, the hotel's early guests would have recognised these recipes, and welcomed them thereafter.

MARTINI	25
Late 1800s USA – First recorded in 1888, evolving from the sweeter Martinez into a drier, crisper drink. Over time, the balance shifted toward London Dry Gin and dry vermouth, creating the clean, minimalist icon of modern mixology.

GOLDEN AGE CLASSICS & PROHIBITION ERA

Opulence, Innovation, & Resilience

As Eichardt's blossomed under the guidance of Julia Eichardt, cocktails were entering their first golden age. The post-Civil War period in America and the Victorian refinement in Europe gave rise to elegant new formulas, while bartending became an art.

Just as Queenstown endured hardship and transformation, so too did the cocktail world, particularly during the Prohibition era, when creativity, secrecy, and resilience shaped underground drinking culture.

It was in this era that Eichardt's achieved international acclaim, attracting visitors from all over the world and became the first building in Queenstown to be lit by electricity. Sophisticated, exciting and inventive; just like the cocktails of the time.



PISCO SOUR 24
1920s Lima – Popularized in Peruvian newspapers, with Chile still claiming ownership of both spirit and cocktail. Silky, meringue-like body with a refreshing sour punch.
Barsol Pisco, Fresh Lime, Simple Syrup, Angostura, Egg White

AVIATION 23
Early 1900s USA – Inspired by the era’s love of flight, said to mirror a twilight sky. Bright, floral, and crisp with a soft violet sweetness.
London Dry Gin, Luxardo Maraschino, Crème de Violette, Lemon, Luxardo Cherry

HANKY PANKY 24
1903 London – Created by Ada “Coley” Coleman for actor Charles Hawtrey, who declared it “the real hanky-panky!”. Bold, complex, with menthol and bitter chocolate notes.
London Dry Gin, Antica Formula Vermouth, Fernet Branca, O range

NEGRONI 25
1919 Florence – Created for Count Camilo Negroni, who requested a stronger Americano. Citrus-bitter aroma with a boozy bite and herbal sweetness.
Gin, Sweet Vermouth, Campari

MARGARITA 28
1920s Mexico/California Border – Born from the “Daisy,” a borderlands creation blending two heritages. Bright, invigorating, with balanced blue agave and lime tartness.
Patrón Silver Tequila, Cointreau, Fresh Lime

BLOODY MARY– EICHARDT’S STYLE 23
1920 Paris – Designed for American expats and Russian refugees, later perfected at the St. Regis in New York. Bright tomato and citrus cut through savory spice and umami depth.
Vodka, Grahams 10yr Tawny Port, Tomato, Fresh Lemon, Worcestershire Sauce, Horseradish, Olives, Balsamic Glaze, Peppercorn & Kaitaia to taste

JUNGLE BIRD 25
1973 Malaysia– A sweet, zesty, and tropical treat, balancing fruity sweetness with bitter citrus.

SIDECAR 24
1920s Paris – Born at the height of post-war elegance, likely at Buck’s Club or Ritz Paris. A refined sour built on Cognac, it delivers sharp citrus, subtle sweetness, and timeless sophistication.
Cognac, Cointreau, Fresh Lemon, Brown Sugar Rim

BRANDY ALEXANDER 23
1922 England – Said to have been refined for Princess Mary’s wedding, swapping gin for brandy. Creamy, velvety, sweet and chocolaty with cocoa and spice.
Cognac, White Crème de Cacao, Brown Crème de Cacao, Cream, Grated Dark Chocolate & Nutmeg

MAI TAI 23
1944 California – Created by Trader Vic as a showcase for aged rum. Tropical yet spirit-forward, with nutty orgeat richness, bright citrus, and bold character that defined the tiki movement.
Pineapple Rum, Spiced Rum, Cointreau, Orgeat, Fresh Lime & Mint

PALOMA 26
1950s Mexico – A bright and refreshing classic, combining tart grapefruit and lime with light sweetness and effervescence.

COSMOPOLITAN 23
1980s New York – A chic, fruity cocktail that brought cranberry and citrus to Manhattan nightlife. Tart, sweet, and perfectly balanced.

BOULEVARDIER 26
1920s Paris – Born at Harry’s New York Bar and named for American ex-pats like, who dubbed themselves “Boulevardiers” in reference to their crawling the boulevards of Paris. A whiskey-backed Negroni, rich, bittersweet, and warming.

Celebrating the link between the inhabitants of the Isle of Skye and Eichardt's. Toasty, fruity, and chocolate notes, finished with a treat.
